

A Resolution to submit to the qualified electors of the City of Pawnee Rock, Kansas, the proposition of eliminating the tax on intangible personal property and authorizing the imposition of certain other taxes.

WHEREAS, the election officer of the County of Barton has determined that a sufficient petition has been filed to call a referendum of the voters under the provisions of K.S.A. 1979, Supp. 79-3109,

Be it Resolved, by the Governing Body of the City of Pawnee Rock, Kansas:

SECTION 1. A special question election shall be held in the manner prescribed by law in the general election on the 4th day of November, 1980, for the purpose of submitting to the qualified electors of the City of Pawnee Rock, Kansas, the question of eliminating the tax on intangible personal property and authorizing the imposition of certain other taxes.

SECTION 2. The proposition to be placed on the ballot shall be in substantially the following form: "Shall the City of Pawnee Rock, Kansas, eliminate the tax on intangible personal property and be authorized to impose and levy any other taxes as may be authorized by law or to levy taxes on real estate and tangible personal property in addition to an aggregate levy amount limitation on the city's ad valorem tax levy authority as may be necessary to offset the revenue lost from elimination of the tax on intangible personal property?"

SECTION 3. The City Clerk and County Election Officer shall cause notices to be published of this special question, as provided by law.
