

RESOLUTION NO. 18

WHEREAS, Pawnee Rock, Kansas desires to further promote fair housing practices in the community, and

WHEREAS, in order to implement activities to assist in the promotion of fair housing practices, it is necessary that the City of Pawnee Rock work with the public, real estate agencies, banks and other lending institutions, to further publicize the assistance available in the community,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Governing Body of Pawnee Rock, Kansas, that the following activities are hereby adopted and approved:

- a) Upon publication of this Resolution, which is hereby approved, the City Clerk's Office is designated as being available to assist persons experiencing discrimination in housing.
- b) That Pawnee Rock, Kansas will work with real estate agencies and banks to end redlining practices and to make available to them, "equal lending opportunity advertisements",

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Pawnee Rock, Kansas, hereby adopts the Kansas Act Against Discrimination, and will provide copies of the Act to any interested person, through the City Clerk's office.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that in order to stimulate public interest in these adopted activities, September 26, 1988 to September 30, 1988 has been proclaimed as being Pawnee Rock, Kansas Fair Housing Awareness Week.
