That the following street and portions of street be improved as follows, to-wit:

To be greded, curbed, guttered end otherwise improved.

Flore Avenue from the west side of the intersection of Flore and Houck Street sest to the sest side of the intersection of Flore Avenue end Rook Street.

That all of the above street improvements be done under the authority of Sections 12-601 and 12-602, at saq., K.S.A., and any amendments thereto.

That said street improvements except intersections, are to be done and constructed at the cost of the respective owners of land, lots and tracts liable to pay special assessments for the costs, thereof as provided by law, unless the resident owners of more than one-half of the property liable for texation therefor protest said improvements within 20 days of LAST publication of this resolution.

That this resolution be published in the official city weekly paper for two consecutive weeks, beginning with the issue of 15 months, 1972, as provided by law.
