RESOLUTION

DEEMING AND DECLARING IT NECESSARY TO IMPROVE A
CERTAIN STREET AND PORTIONS OF STREET WITHIN
THE CITY OF PAWNEE ROCK, BARTON COUNTY, KANSAS:

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF PAWNEE
ROCK, BARTON COUNTY, KANSAS:

That the following street and portions of street be improved
as follows, to-wit:

To be graded, curbed, guttered and otherwise improved.

Flora Avenue from the west side of the intersection of Flora
and Houck Street east to the east side of the intersection of Flora
Avenue and Rook Street.

That all of the above street improvements be done under the
authority of Sections 12-601 and 12-602, et seq., K.S.A., and any
amendments thereto.

That said street improvements except intersections, are to be
done and constructed at the cost of the respective owners of land,
lots and tracts liable to pay special assessments for the costs,
thereof as provided by law, unless the resident owners of more than
one-half of the property liable for taxation therefor protest said
improvements within 20 days of LAST publication of this resolution.

That this resolution be published in the official city weekly
paper for two consecutive weeks, beginning with the issue of 15
March, 1972, as provided by law.
