

## Resolution No. 38

### Resolution for the Discharge of Fireworks on December 31<sup>st</sup>. 1999

Be it in Resolution by the Governing body of the City Of Pawnee Rock, Kansas:

#### Resolution No. 38

##### SECTION 1. Fireworks

- A. Definition: Fireworks shall mean and include any substance or combination of substances, or device prepared for the purpose of producing a visible or an audible effect by combustion, explosion, defloration or detonation, and shall include blank cartridges, toy pistols, toy cannons, toy canes, or toy guns in which explosives are used; firecrackers, torpedoes, skyrockets, Roman Candles, Day-Glo bombs, sparklers, or other devices of like construction and any device containing any explosive substance, except that the terms "fireworks", shall not include any auto flares.

##### SECTION 2. Discharge

- A. It shall be lawful for any person or persons to use or fire any fireworks within the city limits of Pawnee Rock, Kansas, between the hours of 06:00 P.M., On the 31<sup>st</sup> day of December, 1999 until 01:00 A.M on January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2000 in celebration of the change of the millenium.

##### SECTION 3. Seizure of Fireworks

The Pawnee Rock Police Department shall seize, take, remove or cause to be removed at the expense of the owner, all stocks of fireworks offered or exposed for sale, stored, or held in violation of this Resolution
